Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That [§ 9.1-600](#) of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

A. State, local, and other public law-enforcement agencies, which have ten or more law-enforcement officers, shall have procedures as established in subsection B, allowing citizen submission of complaints regarding the conduct of the law-enforcement agency, law-enforcement officers in the agency, or employees of the agency.

B. Law-enforcement agencies shall ensure, at a minimum, that in the case of all written complaints:

1. The general public has access to the required forms and information concerning the submission of complaints;

2. Complaints will be posted publicly on the law-enforcement agency's website

3. The law-enforcement agency assists individuals in filing complaints and will give updates on processing complaints upon request within 3 business days

4. An online guide instructing each step of the filing process will be available on the law-enforcement agency's website

5. Adequate records are maintained of the nature and disposition of such cases; records will be available on the law-enforcement agency website.
